Know all by these presents that the undersigned hereby makes, constitutes and appoints each of Michael O'Neill, Kevin Moriarty and Michael McCoy, each acting individually, as the undersigned's true and lawful attorney-in-fact, with full power and authority as hereinafter described on behalf of and in the name, place and stead of the undersigned to:
